Product Description	A waterbased premium textured interior wall paint designed to look like brushed suede.				
Intended Uses	 For application to suitably primed new smooth cement plaster walls, fibre-board, ceiling board, gypsum plaster. Ideal for living rooms, bedrooms, passages, offices and public buildings where a faux suede finish is required. Ideal for use as a feature wall or above or below a dado rail.

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Surface Preparation

Ensure that surfaces are dry, sound, free from dust, dirt, grease and oil before painting.

1. **NEW WORK**

- 1.1 Cement plaster, concrete, unglazed brickwork, fibre-cement, ceiling boards, gypsum plaster (e.g. Rhinolite, Cretestone): Remove any loose particles and laitance by most suitable means. Prime with MERIT PLASTER PRIMER (UC 56).
- 1.2 **N.B.** Soft, underbound, friable and highly porous surfaces must be restored to a sound condition before painting with **BONDING LIQUID (CVI 14)** (for dry inland areas) or **MERIT PLASTER PRIMER (UC 56)** (for humid and coastal areas) or by replastering refer to Plascon Technical Services Department.
- 1.3 **N.B.:** If a gypsum plaster has been used as the joint skimming filler on gypsum board or dry wall partitioning, then these areas must be sealed with **MERIT PLASTER PRIMER (UC 56)**.
- 2. PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES
- 2.1 Previously painted surfaces in sound condition: Remove loose and flaking paint back to a sound substrate and a firm edge by scraping and sanding. Spot prime bare areas with appropriate primer. Clean with SUGAR SOAP POWDER CLEANER solution to remove all contaminants. Rinse with clean water to remove all traces of SUGAR SOAP POWDER CLEANER. Sand glossy enamel surfaces to a matt finish and apply one coat of MERIT UNIVERSAL UNDERCOAT (UC 1).
- 2.2 **Previously painted surfaces in poor condition:** Completely remove paint by most appropriate means and treat as for new work
- 2.3 **Previously distempered surfaces:** Remove distemper completely with **POLYCELL POLYPEEL** and rinse off thoroughly with water. Allow to dry for at least 48 h and apply one coat of **BONDING LIQUID (CVI 14)** or **MERIT PLASTER PRIMER (UC 56). N.B. BONDING LIQUID** must be overcoated within 72 hours.
- FILLING
 Fill all imperfections with MENDALL 90 ALL PURPOSE ADHESIVE FILLER or POLYFILLA INTERIOR
 CRACK FILLER and spot prime filled areas with MERIT PLASTER PRIMER (UC 56).

Application

• Apply first coat with a long nap roller, brushing all areas that cannot be reached by roller first. To ensure good film of paint avoid overspreading. Allow at least 4 hours drying time before over coating. To achieve suede effect apply second coat with a good quality, Hamilton Perfection or Professional brush (100mm) brush in random criss-cross strokes. Work in areas 1 – 2 square metres. Make sure to overlap criss-cross areas to ensure an even effect. Allow 30 minutes for the effect to appear.
