Surface Preparation	 Ensure that surfaces are dry, sound, free from dust, dirt, grease and oil before painting. Plaster/ Fibre Cement/ Cement Bricks (not suitable for use on Rhinolite) Remove oil, grease and dirt with PLASCON AQUASOLV DEGREASER (GR 1) Remove efflorescence and lime wash by wire brushing. Rinse with clean water and allow to dry. 				
	Application	Apply by brush or roller. It can be sprayed using airless spraying equipment without thinning. However, if dilution is necessary, use a minimum amount of WATER only.
