	AQUASOLV DEGREASER (GR 1). Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow to dry.		
	Surfaces must be sound and dry before painting.		
Application	Thin first coat as recommended. Apply subsequent coats unthinned.		
	 Apply one or more coats to achieve complete obliteration.
